Starting point

- Work on just transition conducted by the International Labour Organisation since 2015, pointing at the need to develop 'coherent' just transition strategies.
- Such strategies should cover a variety of *policy domains*, integrating different *levels of governance* and involving a *variety of stakeholders* (in particular, the social partners)
- The involvement of the social partners in the elaboration and implementation of these policies is extremely varied across Member States, territories within Member States.



- Consequently, we somehow miss the big picture of the elaboration and implementation of just transition policies at the EU and Member States' level.
- The research would be to identify key initiatives for just transition implemented in a number of Member States through policy instruments and initiatives involving multiple levels of governance and, ideally, multiple stakeholders.
- About 8 national case studies?



We could explore

- What kind of policies emerge from these initiatives in terms of contents (which measures have been elaborated/ implemented)?
- How do these instruments and initiatives interact and what is the overall policy framework for just transition that emerges from these interaction (are initiatives at different level coherent and integrated or rather contradictory, implying difficult trade-offs)?
- Crucially, what has been the role of the social partners (incl. employers!) and of social dialogue in the elaboration and implementation of these initiatives for just transition at the different levels of governance?



Three angles

We would address just transition from three angles:

- Policy contents;
- Horizontal integration (interaction between actors); and
- Vertical integration (between the different levels of governance).



Concrete policy initiatives

• Inititives that would allow to grasp these dimensions are:

- the Just Transition Mechanism and the Just Transition Fund
- starting from concrete Just Transition Territorial Plans
- The Recovery and Resilience Facility and the national Recovery and Resilience Plans
 - Including the concrete implementation at the national level of relevant measures in the RRPs and monitoring through the European Semester
- Other instruments could be considered:
